Significant new developments in EC law in 2008

1. Nature protection

The Commission published updated lists of protected habitats for the different biogeographical areas and adopted a list for the steppic regions (Dec.2008/967). Question pending in court (on appeal), whether a landowner may take legal action against the inclusion of his land into the lists of habitats of Community interest. The Advocate General concluded that he could, differing from the Court of First Instance (C-362/07).

Adoption of Regulation 689/2008 on export and import of dangerous chemicals (133 + 175)

Adoption of Regulation 1272/2008 on the labelling of chemicals

Adoption of Regulation 1523/2007 banning trade in cat and dog furs
